FS-1 Basic services of funeral director and staff: \$2,395. This charge cannot be declined by the purchaser. The quoted price includes the recovery of unallocated overhead.

FS-2 The basic services fee is already included in the charges for direct cremation, immediate burial, and forwarding or receiving remains.

FS-3 Principal basic services provided for that fee: arrangements conference, shelter of remains, preparation and filing of permits, coordination with cemetery or crematory, and staff for the service.

FS-4 Embalming: \$895. The home does not require embalming for direct cremation or immediate burial.

Basic services of funeral director and staff \$2,395 This fee for our basic services will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.) Principal basic services provided for this fee: arrangements conference, shelter of remains, preparation and filing of permits, coordination with cemetery or crematory, and staff for the service.

Embalming \$895 Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it,

such as direct cremation or immediate burial.
