WHAT CHANGED, AND WHY

1	Product identifier: Calderhythe Undercoat 40	Product identifier: Calderhythe Primer 40 / Other means of identification: CH-P40; formerly Calderhythe Undercoat 40	CR-1 gives the identifier regulatory approved, and the sheet carried the former trade name in its place. CR-2 records both the code and the former name, so neither is lost. Appendix D provides for other means of identification in section 1.
2	Emergency telephone number: see back page	Emergency telephone number: 1-800-555-0142, staffed 24 hours	CR-5 supplies the number and the hours. A cross-reference to another page is not a telephone number, and section 1 is where a reader in a hurry looks for one.
3	Ingredient A: 1 to 10% (proprietary)	Ingredient A: [Query to regulatory: 1 to 10% is not among the thirteen prescribed ranges at (i)(1)(iv), and it is not two consecutive ones combined. CR-3 gives 6.2%. Two prescribed ranges contain it, and 3 to 7% is the narrower. Please confirm the range and the wording.]	1 to 10 is not among the thirteen prescribed ranges, and (i)(1)(v) permits only a combination of two consecutive ones. CR-3 gives the exact concentration but not a range, and choosing the range is the manufacturer's decision. The word proprietary also does not say what the standard says, which is that the exact concentration is withheld as a trade secret.
4	Revised: 2024	Date of last change: March 2, 2026	Appendix D asks for the date of preparation or the last change. A year is not a date, and CR-6 supplies one. During the transition period a sheet can be written to either version of the standard, so the date is the only thing on the page that places it.
